



RULES ON ENDORSEMENT PROCEDURES

YOUNG REPUBLICAN NATIONAL FEDERATION

In general, the Young Republican National Federation will not make an endorsement in any contested Republican primary or intraparty election.

STATE FEDERATIONS

A State federation may participate or make an endorsement in any contested Republican primary or any intraparty election within their state jurisdiction in the manner and to the extent authorized by its governing documents.

LOCAL CLUBS

A local chapter may participate or make an endorsement in any contested Republican primary or any intraparty election within their state or local jurisdiction in the manner and to the extent authorized by its governing documents and the governing documents of its State Federation.

IN ALL CASES...

Any state federation or local chapter desiring to participate or make an endorsement shall promptly notify the YRNF Chairman upon such participation or endorsement. No such endorsement may in any way, state, imply, or suggest that it is made on behalf of the YRNF and any such implications shall promptly be disavowed by the endorsing organization.

REPUBLICANS ONLY

No officer or member of the National Committee shall endorse, or otherwise publicly encourage support for, any non-Republican candidate in a primary or general election where a Republican candidate appears on the ballot and where candidates are classified on the ballot by political party.

EXCEPTION

These rules do not pertain to elections within the YRNF or any of its state federations or local clubs, or elections within any other Republican Party auxiliary or allied organizations.
